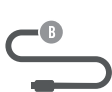


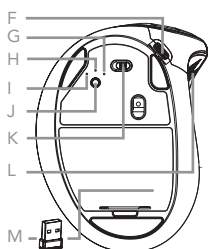
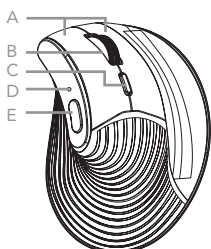

3 Operation

Connect with the USB receiver

- Slide the On/off switch to turn the mouse on.
- Open the case underneath the mouse and take out the USB receiver.
- Connect the USB receiver to your computer's USB port.
- Press the mode button until on USB mode, the USB indicator will flash red.

Connect with Bluetooth®

- Slide the On/off switch to turn the mouse on.
- Press the mode button until on Bluetooth® mode, the Bluetooth® 1 and 2 indicators will flash blue and green slowly.
- Press and hold the mode button until the Bluetooth® 1 and 2 indicators flashes rapidly, indicating it is ready to pair.

For Windows

- Open Bluetooth® devices on your computer and select "add or remove Bluetooth® devices".
- Search for AEM-0222 and select "pair".

For MacOS

- Open System preferences on your computer and select "Bluetooth®".
- Search for AEM-0222 and select "pair".

Charging

- Connect the supplied USB-C charging cable to the USB-C charging port of the mouse and the other end to your power source. While charging, the DPI/channel/charging indicator will light up red.
- Once fully charged (approximately 6 hours), the indicator will light up green.

Troubleshooting



Cannot connect with USB receiver

- Ensure the mouse is on.
- Ensure you are on USB mode, the USB indicator will flash red.
- Try a different USB port on your computer.

Cannot connect via Bluetooth®

- Ensure you are on Bluetooth® mode, the Bluetooth® 1 and 2 indicators will flash blue and green rapidly.
- Ensure your computer's Bluetooth® is turned on.

Installation and Location
