


1 Have you got everything?




Unpack the box (be gentle) and make sure all of these items are there:

A. DAB + Radio
B. Micro USB Cable


C. User Guide
D. Warranty Certificate

Product Overview

1. **VOLUME KNOB:** turn clockwise/anti-clockwise to increase/decrease volume. Press to mute sound.
2. **SLEEP/⏸:** press the button repeatedly to select sleep timers or turn off the sleep timer. Press and hold to enter standby mode or power on.
3. **MODE:** press to switch between modes, press and hold to adjust brightness.
4. **INFO/MENU:** press to view info, press and hold to enter menu settings.
5. **LCD DISPLAY**
6. **SPEAKERS**
7. **ALARM:** press to enter alarm settings.
8. **PRESET:** press to recall FM stations, press and hold to save the FM station.
9. **BACK:** return to previous.
10. **CONTROL KNOB:** turn clockwise/anti-clockwise to play next/previous station. Press to enter selection.
11. **POWER:** turn product on/off.
12. **USB PORT**

13. **MICRO SD/TF CARD PORT**
14. **CHARGING LED LIGHT INDICATOR:** lights up red when charging/green when charged.

15. **DC 5V PORT:** For Micro USB charging.
16. **ANTENNA:** stick out the antenna when using DAB/FM function.

3 Operation

Slide the power switch to ON to turn on the product. It will automatically enter DAB mode and search for radio stations. You can also press and hold the CONTROL KNOB to search again. After searching, the stations with a clear signal will be synchronised and saved. Use the control knob to switch between stations and press the CONTROL KNOB to play the station. Press the MENU/INFO button to view the current station information, frequency, channel number and so on.

Press the MODE button to switch to FM mode. Press and hold the CONTROL KNOB to search for stations, and the stations with a clear signal will be synchronised and saved. Press and hold the PRESET button to save a station and press to bring up the saved station. Use the CONTROL KNOB to switch between stations and press the CONTROL KNOB to play the station. Press the MENU/INFO button to view the current station information, frequency, channel number and so on.

To recall a preset station, press the "PRESET" button and turn the CONTROL KNOB to select the previous/next station. Press the CONTROL KNOB to confirm station.

Press the MODE button repeatedly until it enters Bluetooth® mode; the LCD display screen will show "BT disconnected" and a sound will be heard. On your device, select "BAUHN ADAB-0322" to pair with the product. If successfully connected, the LCD display screen will show "BT connected". You can now start streaming your device's music to the product. Press and hold the CONTROL KNOB to disconnect the device.

Insert a USB into the USB port to play your music files. You can also insert a Micro SD/TF card into the Micro SD/TF card slot. Use the control knob to switch songs, press the control to play/pause.

Press the SLEEP button on any mode to put the product into standby mode. Only the date and alarm status will be displayed on the LCD display screen. In standby mode, press the MENU/INFO button to set the time, date and alarms. You can press the ALARM button to directly enter the alarm settings.

When auto searching for stations, the date and time will automatically synchronise to the station date and time. To set manually, press and hold the MENU/INFO button when on DAB mode and select Time/Date. Use the CONTROL KNOB to set the date and time. Once set, press and hold the MENU/INFO button to exit the menu settings.

2 alarms can be set. Press the ALARM button to enter the alarm settings. Use the CONTROL KNOB to set the time, occurrence and volume. Press the MENU/INFO button to exit the alarm settings. When the set alarm rings, press and hold the VOLUME KNOB to mute the sound and the CONTROL KNOB to set the snooze time.

Note: the date, time and clock will reset when powered off. It will update once the station transmits information to the unit.

Troubleshooting

No sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Station is not tuned in. Press and hold the CONTROL KNOB to search for available stations. Volume is too low/on mute. Use the VOLUME KNOB button to turn the volume up/unmute.
Buttons not working	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Restart the unit.
FM: Static sound DAB: Burbling/ intermittent cut out	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> FM: signal reception is too low. Adjust the antenna or move the unit to a stronger signal location. DAB: re scan stations.
Distorted sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Turn the volume down.
Cannot find desired radio station	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Weak signal. Input a station manually.
Display screen shows "DAB no signal"/ "DAB no station"	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There is no DAB coverage in your area/reception is poor. Adjust the position of antenna and/or move the unit to a stronger signal location.
No sound when on USB/Micro SD mode	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure the USB drive/Micro SD card is in FAT32 file format and no greater than 32GB. Ensure the file format is .mp3 USB port cannot support hard disk.
Some FM stations cannot be searched	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The radio will only keep the strong signal stations. Weak signal stations will be automatically discarded.
