
# Before Using the Product




Please put the monitor in a flat plane to avoid falling and damage.




The warning signs are marked on the back of the monitor, indicating that the adapter is only for safe use at an altitude of 2000m and below.




Do not plug with wet hands, it may cause electric shock. Please make sure that the plug is in good contact. Poor contact may cause a fire.




Please unplug the monitor when cleaning. Do not use industrial chemicals, and be careful not to let water come into contact with the monitor.




Please do not disassemble the monitor by yourself. Contact our Support Team if there is a malfunction.

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
# Installation



1. First, place the monitor face down on a flat surface with a soft cloth underneath.

2. Slide the neck attachment into the back cabinet aligning the plastic slots with the metal neck attachment. Slide forward until a click is heard. If at any stage the stand is to be removed, press the plastic tab on the rear cabinet and slide the neck backwards.


3. Align the base with the base screw hole and insert the screw to fix it

# Connection

## Connecting the cable



HDMI			SOUND & PICTURE	All-digital connection between the monnitor and computer. Supports Full HD resolution. Requires a HDMI cable (included).
VGA			PICTURE	Analog connection between the monitor and any computer. Supports Full HD resolution. Requires a VGA cable (not included).
Headphone			SOUND	Connect to your headphones, amplifier or audio device, using an AUX cable (not included).
DC IN			DC IN	DC power connection. Use only the supplied DC adaptor.

Your monitor can connect to a computer via HDMI or VGA cable.

The preferred way to connect your monitor is via the included HDMI cable as this will provide the best picture quality.

Simply plug one end of the cable into the HDMI port and the other end into your computer.


To connect via VGA cable, use a VGA cable (not included) and plug into the VGA port shown above.

# Position Adjustment

## Adjust the Angle



The screen can be tilted forward and backward. The specific adjustment angle depends on different models. Generally, it is  $5\pm 2$  degrees forward and  $15\pm 2$  degrees backward.




When adjusting the position of the monitor, be careful not to touch or press the screen area.


### Safe wall mounted installation, using wall mounted installation method (not provided)

1. Remove the base;
2. Please install the monitor on the wall using four M4 \* 10mm screws and bolts, as well as the wall \ mounting kit. (Not provided)



# Control Panel

## Key Indication






1	“M”	Activate OSD menu or function confirmation.
2	“▼”	When the menu is activated, it acts as the up or right selection key. Long press to decrease the progress bar. When the menu is closed, it also acts as the volume key.
3	“▲”	When the menu is activated, it acts as the down or left selection key. Long press to increase the progress bar. When the menu is closed, it also acts as the volume key.
4	“E”	When the menu is activated, it acts as an exit key. When the menu is closed, press this button to enter the auto-adjustment function. The auto-adjustment function will automatically set the horizontal or vertical position, clock and focus.
5	“  ”	Power Button; press this button to turn on/off the monitor.



## Display Mode Settings

- Select System from the left sidebar and then click Display on the right.

# Troubleshooting


Problems	Possible solution
The power indicator does not light up	Check if the power is turned on and whether the power cable is connected.
Can't achieve plug and play	Whether the PC matches with plug and play. Whether the display card matches plug and play. Whether the 15-pin D-type connector of the signal cable is bent.
Dim image	Adjust brightness and contrast.
The image bounces or a ripple appears	There may be electrical equipment causing electronic interference nearby.
The power indicator is on (flashing), but there is no image on the monitor	Whether the computer power is turned on. Whether the computer keyboard is plugged in. Whether the signal cable of the monitor is correctly connected to the computer. Check the monitor signal cable plug and make sure that the ends are not bent. Observe the indicator light by pressing the Caps Lock key on the PC keyboard to confirm whether the computer is working.

# Troubleshooting

Problems	Possible solution
Lack of color (red, green, blue)	Check the monitor signal cable and make sure that the pins are not bent
The picture is not in the middle or the size is not right	Adjust the clock (CLOCK)
The image has a color difference (Inaccurate color rendering)	Adjust RGB color or reselect color temperature
Picture fonts are blurred under the VGA signal	Select the hotkey "E"
