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# Safety

- Do not install the projector in sites with direct blowing of warm and cool air-conditioning. Doing so may cause the projector to fail due to moisture condensation or temperature

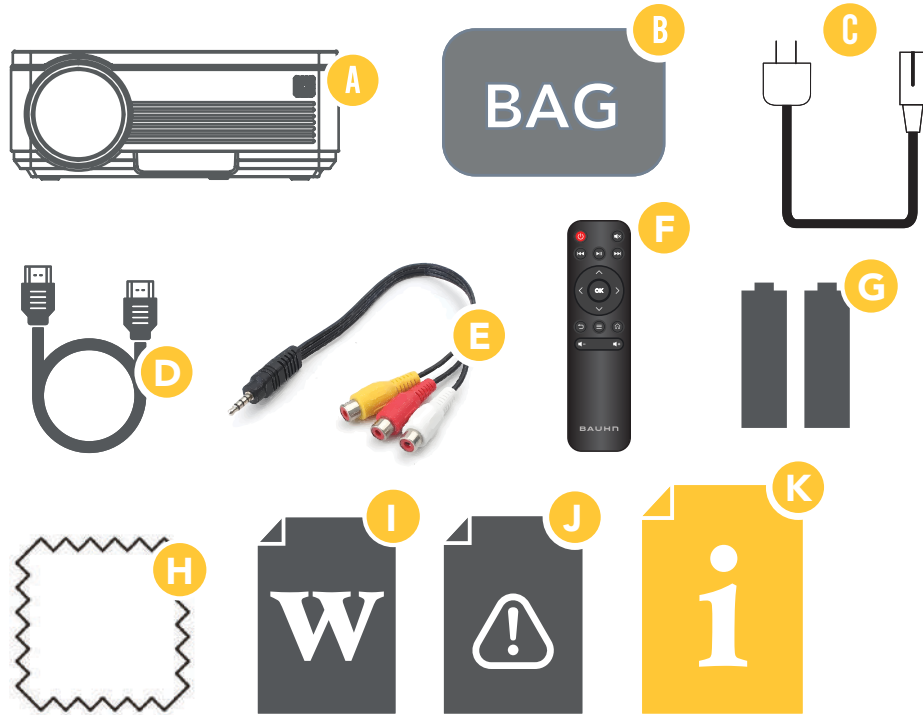


**To avoid possible hearing damage, do not listen at high audio volume for long periods of time.**

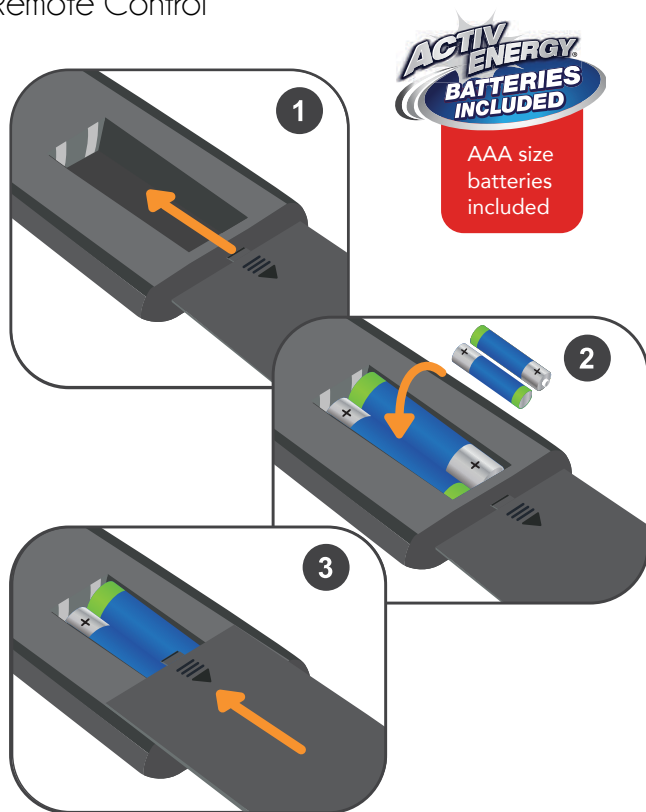
## Ports and Controls



1	<b>HDMI IN</b> Use a high-speed HDMI cable for best picture and sound quality.	 	SOUND PICTURE COMPUTER	All-digital connection between the projector and any HDMI device. Supports HD picture quality. Requires a HDMI cable (included). For Windows 10 computers, you can press the keyboard  + "P" button to quickly connect the projector.
2	<b>AV IN</b>	 	SOUND PICTURE	You can use this to connect your DVD player. Supports standard definition (SD) picture quality. Requires an AV adaptor cable (included) and AV cable (not included).
3	<b>USB</b>	 	MEDIA WIRE SCREEN UPGRADE	Playback media files stored on your USB storage device (supported file codecs and extensions may vary). Connect your iOS and Android smart phone for the wired screen. Update software of the projector..
4	<b>TF/Micro SD</b>	 	MEDIA	Playback media files stored on your TF(Micro SD) card (supported file codecs and extensions may vary).
5	<b>HEADPHONE OUT</b>	 	SOUND	Connect to your headphones, amplifier or audio device, using an AUX cable (not included).

### Remote Control



### Setup

Insert two AAA size batteries according to the polarity markings (+/-) inside the compartment. Make sure the batteries are correctly aligned and properly pushed into place.



#### Precautions When Using Batteries

- Do not use old and new batteries together.
- Do not use different types of batteries (e.g. Manganese and Alkaline batteries) together.
- Remove the batteries from the control remote if you do not intend to use it for a long time.
- When discarding used batteries, follow any guidelines for recycling and disposal of batteries that apply in your local area.
- Keep batteries away from children and pets.
- Never throw batteries into a fire or expose them to extreme heat.

# Operation

## Installation Method

The projector can be placed on the table or mounted on the ceiling to project the image according to the operating environment and requirements. Keep the projector at a height where its lens is axial symmetry to the screen. If this is not possible, use the keystone correction function to adjust the projection image.

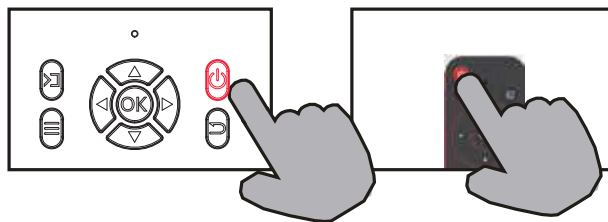
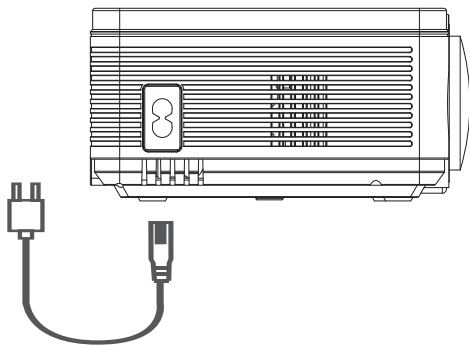
Adjust the Projection Setting menu to flip the projection image direction after installed.

### Projector Screen

Please choose projector screen with better gain, contrast and surface quality in creating the optimum projection experience.

## Power On/Off

Connect to the power cable, press the power button on the unit or remote control to start the projector (indicator will glow blue); press it again to power Off (standby mode) the projector (indicator will glow red).



# Operation cont.

## Focus Adjustment

Adjust the focus wheel of the projector until the picture is clear (please keep the projection distance more than 1m, otherwise it will not focus correctly).



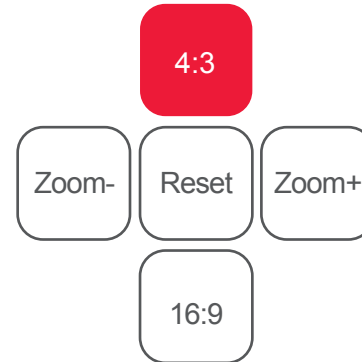
## Keystone Correction

Adjust the Projection Setting menu to correct keystone of the projection image.



## Picture Size Setting

Adjust the Picture Size setting to correct the display area and aspect ratio of the image.



# Operation cont.

## Wired Screen

### Connect iOS Device

1. Connect your iOS device to the projector USB port via the original iOS device charging cable.
2. Please click "Trust" when the iOS device shows a pop-up window.



### Connect Android Device

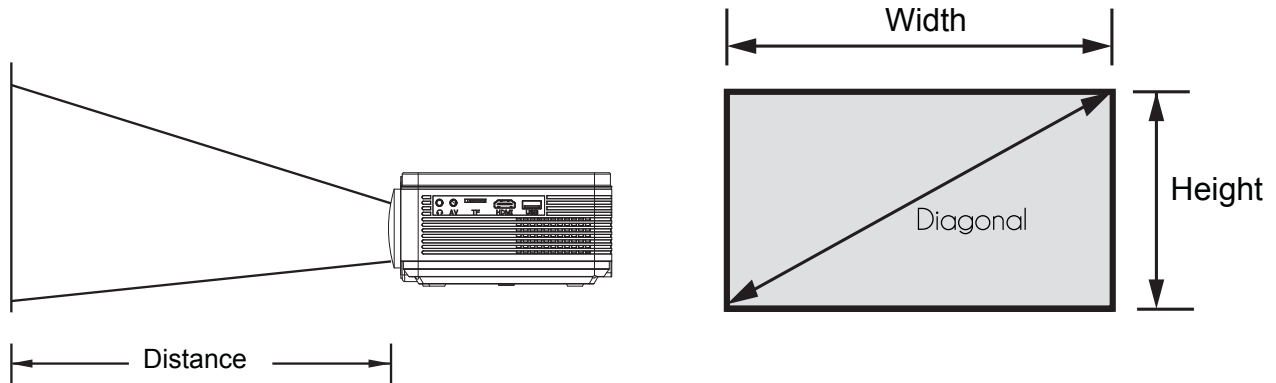
1. Scan the QR code to download and Install the app.
2. Use a USB cable (supports data transferring) to connect your Android device to the projector.
3. Confirm to open the app in the pop-up window of your device.
4. Enter your device password if the app prompted to authenticate the connection.
5. Adjust Screen Mirroring Settings on the app to display full screen on projector.
6. To get a stable connection, some Android devices require selecting "Transfer Files" for screen mirroring.



### Note:

To protect your privacy, some apps on your iOS / Android device may not allow to record / project audio and/or video content on the screen.

# Troubleshooting

Problem	Solution
Projector won't turn on	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Check the power cable is securely connected.</li><li>• Press the power button on the remote control or the top of projector.</li></ul>
The projection screen is blurry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Please keep the projection distance above 1m and adjust the focus until the screen is clear.</li><li>• Please choose projector screen with better gain, contrast and surface quality in creating the optimum projection experience.</li></ul>
Projector is connected to my laptop via HDMI port, but projector keeps "No signal"?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Please make sure your laptop is set to projection mode.</li><li>• If it still fails, please try to connect the projector to other devices such as TV stick with the HDMI cable. If the connection is successful, the projector has no problem.</li><li>• Please check the projection settings of your laptop.</li></ul>
No image showing on projection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Do not place objects between the projector and the screen.</li><li>• Check HDMI, AV or phone cable is securely connected.</li></ul>
No sound from the projector	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Make sure the source or the app is not muted.</li><li>• Check that the plug is not inserted into the headphone port.</li><li>• Increase the volume from the source.</li><li>• Some apps on your iOS / Android device may not allow to record / project audio.</li></ul>

## Lens Maintenance

The projector lens is a crucial component directly impacting picture definition and quality.

Ensure to keep the lens clean from excessive dust.

When cleaning, use a soft cotton cloth suitable for glass lenses.

Avoid using hard cloth or abrasives, as they can damage the lens surface.
